Case Review is a monthly Department of Medical Genetics meeting held on the fourth Wednesday. All GGC clinic faculty meet to conduct business, provide updates and review patient cases. Normally, case review is held in person on the Greenwood campus, but it is currently a virtual meeting.

The Medical Genetics Training Program at GGC offers postgraduate training for PhD laboratory fellows and MD residents. As part of the training, fellows and residents are required to complete a Graduate Course in medical genetics taught by GGC faculty. GGC staff members are always invited to attend any of the course sessions in which they have an interest.

The library also maintains approximately 50 current journal titles and another 50 non-current titles.
